
Sepideh Salehi




Sepideh Salehi's practice painting, photography, utilizes drawing and animation to explore ideas of displacement, memory and violence. Through Salehi's use abstraction of Iranian and iconography and language she challenges and ruminates on her experience as a women immigrant from Iran. She uses language in the form of calligraphy to directly communicate but also as a mode of drawing. She uses negative space and repetition, of both pattern and materials like rice paper, to create delicately intense patterns and compositions that veil and unveil the origin and subject, at times giving protection and obscurity but simultaneously exposing and unearthing vulnerability in memories. uses layering, both physically and conceptually, as a device to conceal emotions through decisive yet sporadic and hypnotizing mark making. Salehi her uses experience as an immigrant as a direct material in her practice manifesting through her hand. Her seemingly meditative and minimal practice complicates itself with the intricacy of the unanswered in a world filled with over sharing and an influx of information.












Mohr Portrait 6, 2014


Mohr Portrait 7, 2015










Red Scarf 1 (Mohr Portrait), 2014 Photography on wood panel with frottage on Japanese paper 24"x20"








Ski 1, 2017 Ink, watercolor and pencil on paper 10"x7"














